LEARN IN THE MOUNTAINS WITH THE COLORADO TRAIL FOUNDATION ESCAPE FOR A WEEK WITH GUDY GASKILL AND A TOP-NOTCH INSTRUCTOR

Golden, CO, May 6, 2006: The Colorado Trail Foundation encourages outdoor enthusiasts to join them for a mountain workshop this summer. They offer 9 week-long classes at their cabin tucked away in the San Juan Mountains of Colorado.

The Colorado Trail Foundation, a non-profit organization, is offering week-long outdoor classes:

Wildflowers, Nature Photography,
Geology, Hiking & Climbing, Painting with Watercolors and Oil,
and a Kids Outdoor Adventure Week.

Teacher enhancement credits are available for some courses. The classes are held in high alpine meadows and pristine valleys and participants stay at the organization's educational facility, a high mountain, chalet-style log cabin above 10,000 feet and surrounded by three 14,000-foot peaks. Courses are taught by top-notch instructors. Participants bring their own tent OR reserve a bed in the tent dormitories. Meals are included. Cost is \$395.
